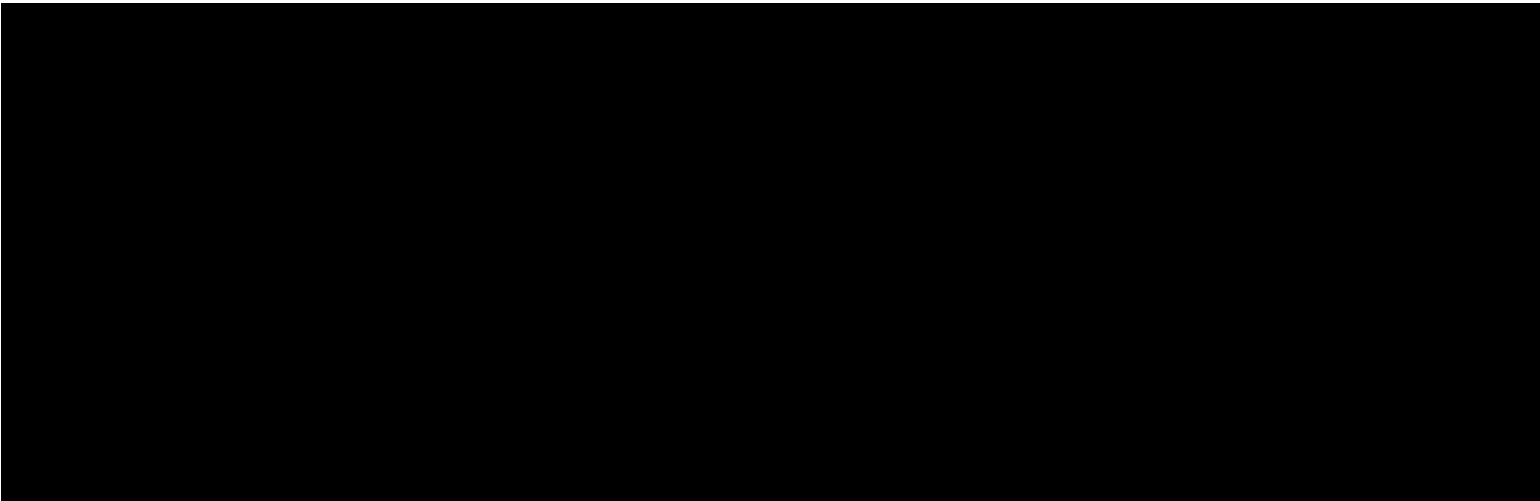

Dear Sir/Madam,

I am writing to formally bring to your attention the unresolved issues pertaining to the Red Line Bus Rapid Transit (BRT) Project in Karachi, which is being co-financed by the Green Climate Fund and the Asian Development Bank.

Previously, a detailed complaint was lodged with the Asian Development Bank on 9th October 2025, highlighting eight critical issues arising from the ongoing construction activities. Following this, a Corrective Action Plan (CAP) was formulated on 10th October 2025 to address these concerns. However, despite the passage of considerable time, most of the agreed corrective measures remain unimplemented.

In light of the above, I humbly request GCF to:

Urgently convene a meeting with the current team working on the ground and other relevant stakeholders;

Ensure immediate implementation of the pending CAP measures;

Facilitate effective coordination to address the outstanding issues on priority.

Please find attached the following documents for your reference:

1. Copy of the agreed Corrective Action Plan (CAP)
2. Fresh letter submitted by the residents of Al Hilal Society

The situation on the ground requires immediate attention, and we look forward to your prompt intervention to ensure that the concerns of the affected residents are addressed without further delay.

Subject: Request for immediate action regarding construction of new NALA and upgradation of sewerage lines prior to ongoing road work in front of Al-Hilal Society, Main University Road, Karachi

Dear Sir,

On behalf of the Residents of Al-Hilal Cooperative Housing Society, the following is submitted for your consideration:

That the BRT Red Line project is currently in progress, and road construction work has started in front of Al-Hilal Cooperative Housing Society, Main University Road, Opp. Askari Park, Karachi. As compared to the previous condition, the University Road has become narrow and its width has been significantly reduced. Consequently, there is a constant risk of accidents, and some incidents have already been reported.

That however, as the main objective of our request is the installation of a new drainage NALA, which forms part of the project and the sewerage line along this NALA is in poor condition, with multiple breakages and contamination with drainage water, resulting sewerage water overflows again and again.

That due to this condition, Streets No. 1 to 5 are repeatedly flooded with drainage and sewerage water. Street No. 1 is particularly affected due to the incoming NALA from the Liaquat National Hospital side, which requires urgent winching and proper cleaning and it is also open at several points, resulting garbage accumulation and frequent overflow. It should therefore be properly covered.

That in view of the above, the issues regarding drainage, sewerage, and the narrow road are affecting not only the residents of Al-Hilal Society but also nearby areas, including Chandni Chowk and Block 14, Gulshan-e-Iqbal. It is therefore requested that the main issues of installation of a new nala and upgradation of the sewerage system be addressed on priority before completion of the road construction.

Otherwise, the Society will be compelled to take legal action to protect the interests of its residents.
