RIGHT TO PETITION

I, [REDACTED] with ID number [REDACTED] issued in San Vicente del Caguan, am writing to you at the FAO to explain to you why I have the right to petition. I am one of the people identified and a beneficiary of the *Huertas Caseras* (home vegetable gardens) project that was part of the food security of Isla Grande district, where we have an association called Asoveigra, of which I am still a member. As a member, I wish to inform you that the [REDACTED] told me that my benefit had arrived in the district but they never gave it to me or made a formal call, either by [REDACTED], or [REDACTED], as they are the person in charge of distributing the home vegetable gardens. I should point out that the vegetable gardens were left for us as people who were identified to deliver them to the people who were not in the region at that time, and others who were not identified. Having understood from what had happened, I went to the person in charge, who is [REDACTED] to ask them for clarification about my vegetable garden, and he rudely answered that they cannot instruct a police officer to walk over for people, and also confirming to me that my quota had been assigned to the school. With this response from [REDACTED] I went to the secretariat of Asoveigra and to the secretariat of the JAC, and they told me that they did not know that my quota that was among the vegetable gardens they had distributed, and to this day I have not had clarification about my vegetable garden. I also wish to inform you that I quit the JAC on 5/10/2024 because of internal conflicts that arose and which I do not agree with, but I have not quit the Asoveigra association. I also wish to add that unscrupulous people including the [REDACTED] wrote a letter of resignation that was undated, and several documents not clarifying and with that bears the signature of [REDACTED]. Looking at [REDACTED] and [REDACTED]

██████████ and which arbitrarily insult. They now call me to tell me they need to interview me and take photos of my land and of me, and also take a statement saying whether or not I am still a member of Asoveigra. For one year now I have been living in the Pereginos █████ district, a district that is also part of the Paraiso Amazonico forestry and biodiversity development hub, so I do not see why they should exclude me from any form of benefit that I get from the Asoveigra association, and the Paraiso Amazonico forestry and biodiversity development hub. I should also mention that I have the evidence mentioned in this letter.
