

IRM Outreach in Africa

1. Overview

As part of its mandate, the Independent Redress Mechanism (IRM) addresses complaints from individuals who believe they are, or may be, negatively impacted by projects or programs funded by the Green Climate Fund (GCF).

To reach potentially affected individuals and raise awareness about its mission and values, the IRM collaborates with civil society organizations (CSOs) to host quarterly outreach webinars. These webinars target regional CSOs and local communities, reinforcing the IRM's presence at both local and regional levels.

On 14 August 2024, the IRM will host an outreach webinar specifically for regional CSOs and local communities in Africa.
